REPORT: The Safe School Initiative of the U.S. Dept. of Ed and U.S. Secret Service recommend pro-active partnerships consisting of educators, police, probation officers and judges.

STUDY: Schools in several states that were classed "persistently dangerous" adopted such programs and not only got off the list but moved up the test score ladder.

PARENTS: Given the chance to change schools, a majority of parents forego the opportunity. They want increased safety in their own school rather than a bus ride across town.

PROMPT REACTION ISN'T GOOD ENOUGH when an assault, rape or murder has already occurred. Congress has changed regulations to allow greater communication and cooperation by your school or department. You are expected to take note and **BE PROACTIVE**, recognizing and intercepting *impending* trouble.

TEACHERS CAN NAME FROM MEMORY their good students and their troublemakers; actual reports show that the ones they can't name are the most serious *safety* threats

FERPA and HIPAA changes now allow open communication about students in nearly all serious situations.
